Due to K.H.S.A.A. rules no more than three seniors from each of the three schools can play. One team will consist of Minneola and Ashland seniors and the other team will be made up of South Central seniors. We would like the girl(s) that are not selected to play to be a part of the event as managers or help in some way; this would allow them the opportunity to meet the players and coaches and be a part of the event. As we get players confirmed to play we will post them on the website at wepacthehouse.com.

If chosen you would be expected to be at the practice on Saturday, October 5, from noon – 3 p.m. at the South Central gym in Coldwater, KS. Tip off time is set for 6:00 p.m.

Fans can purchase tickets beginning September 1 for \$25 each. Ticket sale locations will be announced later. Each ticket holder will receive a T-shirt to wear to the game. Because of K.H.S.A.A. rules we are unable to give the high school players anything. However, you can purchase a T-shirt at a reduced rate.
